\*Estimated monthly payment is based on twelve (12) monthly payments beginning in May 2010 and ending in April 2011. Enrollment after May 1 will result in a higher monthly payment. All payment terms end in April 2011. Monthly payment amount does not include Tuition Refund Plan tuition insurance.

## EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM FEES

Before school care is available beginning at 7:15 am at no additional charge. Advance registration is required. "Lunch Bunch" is offered for half-day preschool children from noon to 3:00 p.m. at an additional cost of \$18 per day. Discounts are available for advance registration. After school care is available to all students from 3:00 pm until 5:30 pm at an additional cost of \$16 per day, or a discounted annual fee for full 5-day enrollment of \$1915. Discounted rates are available with pre-registration for all extended day program options. Contact the Academy office for a price quote.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

### Full Payment

Families who pay in full prior to May 1 will receive an additional two percent (2%) tuition discount and are eligible for the discounted annual tuition rate noted above. Families who pay in full prior to August 1 are not required to purchase tuition insurance.

### Monthly, Quarterly, or Semi-Annual Budgeted Payment Options

Families may choose to budget tuition payments through FACTS Management Company by setting up an online account at [www.factsmgt.com](http://www.factsmgt.com). These payments can be made by automatic bank debit or credit card. An additional convenience fee is applied for credit card payments made through FACTS. Families who choose to budget payments with FACTS will be required to purchase tuition insurance.

## TUITION INSURANCE FEES

All families choosing to budget through a payment plan are required to purchase tuition insurance through the A.W.G. Dewar Tuition Refund Plan. This program protects the family's annual financial commitment against loss due to student withdrawal or dismissal. The cost of the plan is 2.7% of the full annual tuition (prior to any discounts or tuition assistance) and the premium payment is due, in full, prior to May 1 or upon submission of the signed enrollment contract. # Tuition & Fees (continued)

## ADDITIONAL FEES

Fees for after school athletic programs, lunches, and major field trips are not included in the tuition and fees schedule noted in this document. Major field trips for 4th through 8th grades are an important and vital part of the curriculum, but are optional and cost extra.



## UNIFORMS

Families with students in kindergarten through 8th grades are required to purchase school uniforms through the Academy-approved vendor. Students in 5th through 8th grades are required to wear P.E. uniforms, which also must be purchased from the same vendor.

## VIP FAMILY SERVICE PROGRAM OPTIONS

As part of the home-school partnership, all Academy families are expected to participate in the VIP (Very Important Parent) Family Service Program or pay an annual fee in lieu of participation. Families with children in preschool serve ten (10) hours annually; families with children in kindergarten through eighth grades give twenty (20) hours (per family, not per student). Families receiving tuition assistance may have additional VIP service expectations. Families choosing not to participate are expected to pay a fee in lieu of participation (\$175 for half-day preschool families; \$350 for full-day PK-8th families).



## DISCOUNTS

Multiple students from the same family are eligible for a ten percent (10%) discount applied to the second child and any additional children. This discount is available upon written request at the time of application.

## FINANCIAL AID

### Academy Tuition Assistance Program (TAP)

Need-based financial aid is available for eligible K-8th grade students from the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP). TAP applicants must complete an application through FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment at [www.factstuitionaid.com](http://www.factstuitionaid.com) before March 1. Applicants who apply for tuition assistance after March 1 may be eligible for assistance only when TAP funding is available.

### Florida's Corporate Tax Credit (CTC) Scholarship: Step Up For Students

Some families may be eligible for Step Up For Students corporate tax credit tuition grants ([www.stepupforstudents.org](http://www.stepupforstudents.org)).

### Pastoral Scholarship Program

Full time, ordained pastors currently serving in ministry may apply for a pastoral scholarship through the Academy.

## INSUFFICIENT FUNDS AND LATE PAYMENTS

Checks or automatic withdrawals returned for insufficient funds are subject to a \$30 service fee. Report cards may be withheld until all payments are current. No student may re-enroll in a new school year unless all payments for the prior year have been made. Late payments are subject to late fees, interest, and collection fees as allowable by law. Payments that are thirty (30) days late may cause student dismissal as per Academy policy.
